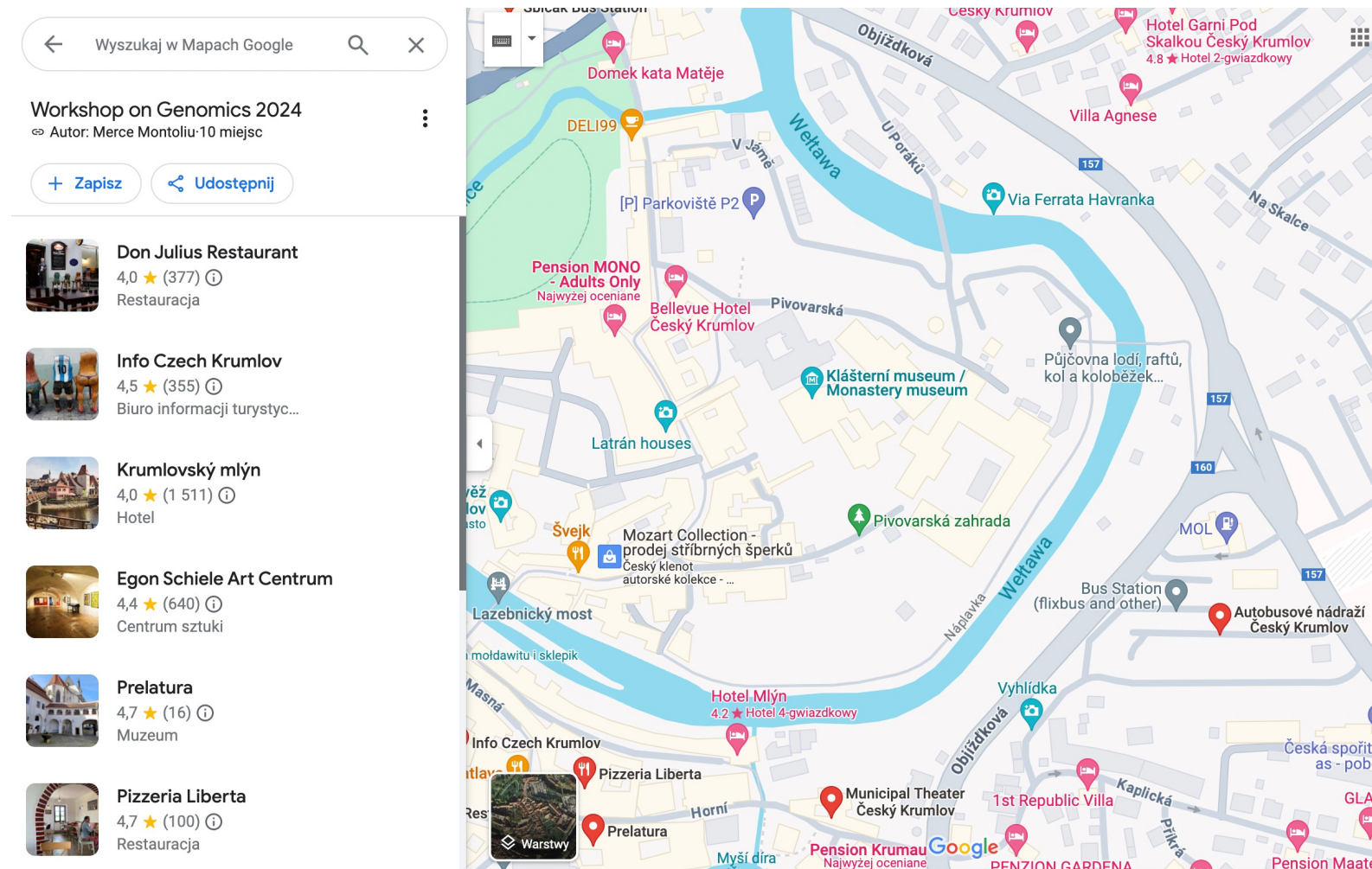

EVOMICS WORKSHOPS CODE OF CONDUCT

All attendees, instructors and faculty at our workshops are required to agree with the Evomics Workshops code of conduct. Organisers will enforce this code throughout the event. Those found to be in violation of this code of conduct will be subject to expulsion from all Workshop activities at the request of the workshop organisers.

Our Code of Conduct

Our workshops are dedicated to providing a supportive and harassment-free environment for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion (or lack thereof), or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of workshop participants, instructors or faculty in any form.

House of Prelate (computer lab)
